


## Configuring the Check Clarion Service

### Batch File


When using the Windows Task Scheduler to run the Clarion Check Service executable please ensure that you are actually running the batch file enclosed. The Windows Task Scheduler looks at the Windows folder unless you specify a change of folder by using the batch file

### Settings


The ServiceCheckSettings executable allows you to define which services are checked on a regular cycle.



### Settings – Configuration of Cycle


The default is 60 seconds between checks


### Settings – Services to Check List

This will show you the details of services being checked




### Settings – Add a new service
